I AM SENT TO MY NATION

In the church at Antioch there were prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen (who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch) and Saul. While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." So after they had fasted and prayed, they placed their hands on them and sent them off. The two of them, sent on their way by the Holy Spirit, went down to Seleucia and sailed from there to Cyprus. The Power of Church Planting

1. Church Planting was <u>INITIATED</u> and is <u>SUSTAINED</u> by God.

I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God made it grow.

2. Church Planting is the most <u>EFFECTIVE</u> way to impact <u>LOSTNESS</u>. So the churches were strengthened in the faith and grew daily in numbers.

3. Church Planting best helps us fulfill the GREAT COMMISSION.

The Priority of Church Planting

1. It's a priority because... less than 18% of Americans faithfully ATTEND CHURCH.

- 2. It's a priority because... new churches add 60% + of its members by CONVERSION.
- 3. It's a priority because... churches that plant churches also GROW THEMSELVES.
- The Principles Behind Effective Church Planting
 - 1. The importance of PRE-PLANTING PRAYER.

 During the night Paul had a vision of a man of Macedonia standing and begging him,

 "Come over to Macedonia and help us." After Paul had seen the vision, we got ready at once to leave for Macedonia, concluding that God had called us to preach the gospel to them.

2. The decision to follow a STRATEGIC PLAN.

"But don't begin until you count the cost. For who would begin construction of a building without first getting estimates and then checking to see if there is enough money to pay the bills?"

3. The willingness to <u>DISCOVER</u> and to <u>SEND</u> the right <u>PEOPLE</u>.

He told them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field."

4. Making sure you are willing to <u>PAY</u> for it... being <u>GENEROUS</u>.

Now about the collection for God's people: Do what I told the Galatian churches to do. On the first day of every week, each one of you should set aside a sum of money in keeping with his income, saving it up, so that when I come no collections will have to be made.
