- 2. We see a heart that has great CHARACTER.
- 3. We see a heart that is **CONNECTED** to God.
- Key Truth: The heart of a servant reflects the <u>HEART</u> of <u>CHRIST</u>.
 Instead of this, of his own free will (Jesus) gave up all he had, and took the nature of a servant. He became like a human being and appeared in human likeness.

❖ The <u>ATTITUDE</u> of a Servant:

- 2. The FAITH to honor God with a HOLY LIFE.
- 3. The MIND that believes that God has the POWER to use me no matter what.
- ➤ Key Truth: A servant must make the <u>MENTAL</u> <u>DECISION</u> to follow Christ. Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is--his good, pleasing and perfect will.
