1. A Godly Mom knows that her children are a <u>GIFT</u> from <u>GOD</u>. Children are a gift from the Lord; they are a real blessing.

- 2. A Godly Mom understands the need for GOD'S HELP.
- A Godly Mom wants what is God's <u>BEST</u> for her <u>CHILDREN</u>. Once I was young, and now I am old. Yet I have never seen the godly forsaken, nor seen their children begging for bread.

A Mom's Heart on <u>OVER-DRIVE</u>: The Danger of choosing <u>FEELINGS</u> over <u>FAITH</u> If you refuse to discipline your children, it proves you don't love them; if you love your children, you will be prompt to discipline them.

Proverbs 13:24 (NLT)

1. There is the danger of being <u>OVER-PROTECTIVE</u>. It's like this: When I was a child, I spoke and thought and reasoned as a child does. But when I grew up, I put away childish things.

 "Can a mother forget her nursing child? Can she feel no love for a child she has borne? But even if that were possible, I would not forget you!"

Isaiah 49:15 (NLT)

 A Godly Mom demands <u>PROPER RESPECT</u>.
 "Respect your father and mother" is the first commandment that has a promise added: so that all may go well with you, and you may live a long time in the land.

3. A Godly Mom teaches <u>REAL RESPONSIBILITY</u>. Teach your children to choose the right path, and when they are older, they will remain upon it.

4. A Godly Mom establishes <u>CLEAR BOUNDARIES</u>. Correction and discipline are good for children. If they have their own way, they will make their mothers ashamed of them.

Proverbs 29:15 (TEV)

 A Godly Mom protects her children from the <u>WORLD'S</u> <u>TEMPTATIONS</u>.
 "Do not give any of your children to be sacrificed to Molech, for you must not profane the name of your God. I am the Lord."

Leviticus 18:21 (NIV)

6. A Godly Mom exemplifies a <u>HEART</u> for <u>GOD</u>. (*Timothy*) I know that you sincerely trust the Lord, for you have the faith of your mother, Eunice, and your grandmother, Lois.

2 Timothy 1:5 (NLT)

A Godly Mom rejoices as Her children <u>FOLLOW</u> <u>CHRIST</u>.
 I have no greater joy than to hear that my children are walking in the truth.
