RE-CONNECT WITH GOD

Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God--this is your spiritual act of worship. - 4. RE-CONNECT with your <u>HABITS</u>

- 5. RE-CONNECT with GOD'S WORD

 ... be transformed by the renewing of your mind.
- 6. RE-CONNECT with God's <u>PRESENCE</u> and <u>POWER</u>
 ... be able to test and approve what God's will is... His perfect will.

- 2. How has God SURPRISED you during this journey; what are you seeing Him do?
- 3. What are you seeing happen as others use this resource to re-connect with God?
