- The Promise of Forgiveness: "Brothers, listen! In this man Jesus there is forgiveness for your sins."

1. Through His forgiveness we are made <u>RIGHTEOUS</u> before God. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

1 John 1:9 (NIV)

2. Through His forgiveness our sins are <u>REMEMBERED</u> no more. For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more.

Hebrews 8:12 (NIV)

3. Through His forgiveness we have been <u>REDEEMED</u> by Jesus. In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace.

Ephesians 1:7 (NIV)

- > Key Truth: By receiving Jesus' forgiveness, you receive His <u>PROMISES</u>.
- The Purpose of Forgiveness:

(God) who has saved us and called us to a holy life--not because of anything we have done but because of his own purpose and grace. This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time...

2 Timothy 1:9 (NIV)

 God's purpose for you is to be <u>SAVED</u> into His <u>FAMILY</u>. How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know him.

1 John 3:1 (NIV)

2. God's purpose for you is to be <u>SEALED</u> with His <u>SPIRIT</u>. Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."

3. God's purpose for you is to be <u>SET APART</u> as <u>HOLY</u>. But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: "Be holy, because I am holy."
