IT'S A MATTER OF THE HEART Mark 7:1-23

"For John came neither eating nor drinking, and they say, 'He has a demon.' ¹⁹The Son of Man came eating and drinking, and they say, 'Here is a glutton and a drunkard, a friend of tax collectors and sinners.' But wisdom is proved right by her actions."

Matthew 11:18-19 (NIV)

Where Does Your Truth Come From?

The Pharisees and some of the teachers of the law who had come from Jerusalem gathered around Jesus ²and saw some of his disciples eating food with hands that were unclean, that is, unwashed. ³(The Pharisees and all the Jews do not eat unless they give their hands a ceremonial washing, holding to the tradition of the elders... ⁵So the Pharisees and teachers of the law asked Jesus, "Why don't your disciples live according to the tradition of the elders instead of eating their food with unclean hands?"

Mark 7:1-3, 5 (NIV)

- 1. Don't be a <u>PHARISEE</u>.
- 2. Dangerous DECEPTIONS.
- 3. When our <u>RULES</u> become other's <u>REQUIREMENTS</u>.
- When Religious Tradition Trumps Biblical Truth:

He replied, "Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you hypocrites; as it is written: "These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. ⁷They worship me in vain; their teachings are but rules taught by men.' ⁸You have let go of the commands of God and are holding on to the traditions of men." ⁹And he said to them: "You have a fine way of setting aside the commands of God in order to observe your own traditions! ¹⁰For Moses said, 'Honor your father and your mother,' and, 'Anyone who curses his father or mother must be put to death.' ¹¹But you say that if a man says to his father or mother: Whatever help you might otherwise have received from me is Corban (that is, a gift devoted to God), ¹²then you no longer let him do anything for his father or mother. ¹³Thus you nullify the word of God by your tradition that you have handed down. And you do many things like that." ¹⁴Again Jesus called the crowd to him and said, "Listen to me, everyone, and understand this. ¹⁵Nothing outside a man can make him unclean by going into him. Rather, it is what comes out of a man that makes him unclean."

Mark 7:6-15 (NIV)

- 1. Don't be a <u>HYPOCRITE</u>... saying one thing and doing something else.
- 2. Don't substitute your <u>PERSONAL BELIEFS</u> for the <u>WORD</u> of <u>GOD</u>.
- 3. Don't misunderstand striving to FOLLOW RULES versus striving for HOLINESS.

It Really is a Matter of the Heart:

After he had left the crowd and entered the house, his disciples asked him about this parable. ¹⁸ "Are you so dull?" he asked. "Don't you see that nothing that enters a man from the outside can make him unclean?" ¹⁹For it doesn't go into his heart but into his stomach, and then out of his body." (In saying this, Jesus declared all foods "clean.") ²⁰He went on: "What comes out of a man is what makes him unclean. ²¹For from within, out of men's hearts, come evil thoughts, sexual immorality, theft, murder, ²²adultery, greed, malice, deceit, lewdness, envy, slander, arrogance and folly. ²³All these evils come from inside and make a man "unclean.""

Mark 7:17-23 (NIV)

- 1. Nothing that you eat <u>DEFILES</u> you... makes you <u>UNCLEAN</u>.
- 2. It is what you allow into your <u>HEART</u> that defiles you and leads to <u>SIN</u>.
- 3. Bottom line, it is what is in your <u>HEART</u> that defines who you <u>REALLY ARE</u>.
 - Check your heart... does it measure up to God's plan for your life?
