## **CHOOSING TO LOVE LIKE JESUS**

The Pharisees heard that Jesus was gaining and baptizing more disciples than John, <sup>2</sup>although in fact it was not Jesus who baptized, but his disciples. <sup>3</sup>When the Lord learned of this, he left Judea and went back once more to Galilee. <sup>4</sup>Now he had to go through Samaria.

John 4:1-4 (NIV)

- ❖ Going Beyond Your Walls... by <u>INITIATING</u> the <u>CONVERSATION</u>.
  - So he came to a town in Samaria called Sychar, near the plot of ground Jacob had given to his son Joseph. <sup>6</sup>Jacob's well was there, and Jesus, tired as he was from the journey, sat down by the well. It was about the sixth hour. <sup>7</sup>When a Samaritan woman came to draw water, Jesus said to her, "Will you give me a drink?" <sup>8</sup>(His disciples had gone into the town to buy food.) <sup>9</sup>The Samaritan woman said to him, "You are a Jew and I am a Samaritan woman. How can you ask me for a drink?" (For Jews do not associate with Samaritans.)

    John 4:5-9 (NIV)
  - 1. "Jacob's well was there..." This well was 100 FEET deep.
  - 2. "... the sixth hour." The middle of the day; hot; around 12 NOON.
  - 3. "You are a Jew and I am a Samaritan woman." They didn't LIKE each other.
  - ➤ Key Truth: God will lead you <u>BEYOND</u> your <u>WALLS</u> if you let Him.
- Going Beyond Your Walls... by discovering a <u>COMMON INTEREST</u>.
  - Jesus answered her, "If you knew the gift of God and who it is that asks you for a drink, you would have asked him and he would have given you living water." <sup>11</sup>"Sir," the woman said, "you have nothing to draw with and the well is deep. Where can you get this living water? <sup>12</sup>Are you greater than our father Jacob, who gave us the well and drank from it himself, as did also his sons and his flocks and herds?" <sup>13</sup>Jesus answered, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life." <sup>15</sup>The woman said to him, "Sir, give me this water so that I won't get thirsty and have to keep coming here to draw water."

John 4:10-15 (NIV)

- 1. "If you knew... you would ask for living water." Jesus creates INTEREST by her.
- 2. "Are you greater than our father Jacob?" She's <u>RELIGIOUS</u>; no <u>RELATIONSHIP</u>.
- 3. "Sir give me this water so I don't have to keep coming here." Sir meet MY NEED.
- ➤ Key Truth: People are seeking <u>SHORT-CUTS</u> to meet their <u>PERCEIVED NEEDS</u>.
- ❖ Going Beyond Your Walls... by getting to <u>KNOW THEM</u> personally.

He told her, "Go, call your husband and come back." <sup>17</sup>"I have no husband," she replied. Jesus said to her, "You are right when you say you have no husband. <sup>18</sup>The fact is, you have had five husbands, and the man you now have is not your husband. What you have just said is quite true." <sup>19</sup>"Sir," the woman said, "I can see that you are a prophet. <sup>20</sup>Our fathers worshiped on this mountain, but you Jews claim that the place where we must worship is in Jerusalem." <sup>21</sup>Jesus declared, "Believe me, woman, a time is coming when you will worship the Father neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem. <sup>22</sup>You Samaritans worship what you do not know; we worship what we do know, for salvation is from the Jews. <sup>23</sup>Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. <sup>24</sup>God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in spirit and in truth." <sup>25</sup>The woman said, "I know that Messiah (called Christ) is coming. When he comes, he will explain everything to us."

John 4:16-25 (NIV)

- "Call your husband... I have no husband." Jesus speaks <u>TRUTH</u>, not <u>JUDGEMENT</u>.
- 2. "Sir I can see you are a prophet..." Woman wants to CHANGE the SUBJECT.
- 3. "I know that the Messiah is coming..." She shows she is LOOKING for a SAVIOR.
- Key Truth: When sharing your faith, don't <u>ARGUE</u> or <u>JUDGE</u>, just share <u>JESUS</u>.
- ❖ Going Beyond Your Walls... by allowing God to <u>CHANGE</u> their <u>LIFE</u>.

  Then Jesus declared, "I who speak to you am he." ... <sup>28</sup>Then, leaving her water jar, the woman went back to the town and said to the people, <sup>29</sup>"Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did. Could this be the Christ?" <sup>30</sup>They came out of the town and made

everything I ever did. Could this be the Christ?" <sup>30</sup>They came out of the town and made their way toward him... <sup>39</sup>Many of the Samaritans from that town believed in him because of the woman's testimony, "He told me everything I ever did." <sup>40</sup>So when the Samaritans came to him, they urged him to stay with them, and he stayed two days. <sup>41</sup>And because of his words many more became believers. <sup>42</sup>They said to the woman, "We no longer believe just because of what you said; now we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this man really is the Savior of the world."

John 4:26, 28-30, 39-42 (NIV)

- 1. "Leaving her water jar..." she now has a DIFFERENT FOCUS.
- 2. "He told me everything I ever did..." she now knows REAL LOVE.
- 3. "... we know that He is the Savior..." Her change leads to other CHANGED LIVES.
- ➤ Key Truth: When someone meets Jesus their PRIORITIES and FOCUS changes.
- Closing Challenge: Go beyond your walls and <u>LOVE</u> like <u>JESUS</u>.

Meanwhile his disciples urged him, "Rabbi, eat something." <sup>32</sup>But he said to them, "I have food to eat that you know nothing about." <sup>33</sup>Then his disciples said to each other, "Could someone have brought him food?" <sup>34</sup>"My food," said Jesus, "is to do the will of him who sent me and to finish his work. <sup>35</sup>Do you not say, 'Four months more and then the harvest?' I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest. <sup>36</sup>Even now the

reaper draws his wages, even now he harvests the crop for eternal life, so that the sower and the reaper may be glad together. <sup>37</sup>Thus the saying 'One sows and another reaps' is true. <sup>38</sup>I sent you to reap what you have not worked for. Others have done the hard work, and you have reaped the benefits of their labor."

John 4:31-38 (NIV)

- > Initiate the conversation
- > Find a common interest
- > Get to know them personally
- > Introduce them to Jesus & let God change their Heart.
