GOD IS ALWAYS AT WORK AROUND YOU John 5:16-20 (NIV)

So, because Jesus was doing these things on the Sabbath, the Jewish leaders began to persecute him. ¹⁷In his defense Jesus said to them, "My Father is always at his work to this very day, and I too am working." ¹⁸For this reason they tried all the more to kill him; not only was he breaking the Sabbath, but he was even calling God his own Father, making himself equal with God. ¹⁹Jesus gave them this answer: "Very truly I tell you, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does. ²⁰For the Father loves the Son and shows him all he does. Yes, and he will show him even greater works than these, so that you will be amazed."

John 5:16-20 (NIV)

- When is God Working?
 - <u>ALWAYS</u>! (Psalm 121:3-4 & Philippians 1:6) He will not let your foot slip—he who watches over you will not slumber; indeed, he who watches over Israel will neither slumber nor sleep.

Psalm 121:3-4 (NIV)

For I am confident of this, He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.

Philippians 1:6 (NIV)

- Even when it doesn't seem like it! (2 Peter 3:9) The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance. 2 Peter 3:9 (NIV)
- What is God Working On?
 - God is <u>RECONCILING</u> the world to Himself. God is going to <u>USE</u> you to <u>BRING</u> someone to Jesus. (2 Corinthians 5:17-21)

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here! ¹⁸All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: ¹⁹that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. ²⁰We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God. ²¹God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

2 Corinthians 5:17-21 (NIV)

• God is <u>HELPING</u> those in the world who are in need. God is going to use you to <u>ANSWER</u> someone else's <u>PRAYER</u>. (1 Corinthians 9:9-11)

Now he who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness. ¹¹You will be enriched in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God.

2 Corinthians 9:10-11 (NIV)

 God Is <u>BUILDING</u> His kingdom and His church. God is going to use you to bring <u>LIGHT</u> to the <u>DARKNESS</u>. (1 Corinthians 3:5-7 & Matthew 5:14-16)

What, after all, is Apollos? And what is Paul? Only servants, through whom you came to believe—as the Lord has assigned to each his task. ⁶I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God has been making it grow. ⁷So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow.

1 Corinthians 3:5-7 (NIV)

"You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. ¹⁵Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. ¹⁶In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven."
