❖ Hope that comes from a clear <u>DIRECTION</u> because we have <u>LOST</u> our <u>WAY</u>:

1. Christmas introduces <u>GOD'S ANSWER</u> to a <u>DARK WORLD</u>.

2. Christmas reveals God's <u>PURPOSE</u> and <u>PATH</u> for our lives.

"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

2. Christmas opened a <u>24-HOUR HOTLINE</u> to Heaven.

❖ Hope from our <u>FEARS</u> that come when <u>DOUBTS</u> attack us:

And He will be called ... Mighty God...

1. Christmas CONFIRMS the POWER of GOD.

# 2. Christmas CONNECTS us to the ALL-POWERFUL God.

"I am sure that nothing can separate us from God's love—not life or death, not angels or spirits, not the present or the future, <sup>39</sup> and not powers above or powers below. Nothing in all creation can separate us from God's love for us in Christ Jesus our Lord!"

And He will be called ... Everlasting Father ...

## 1. Christmas PROVES how IMPORTANT we are to God.

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God... <sup>14</sup>The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

## 2. Christmas OFFERS us an ETERNAL PERSPECTIVE on life.

And we know that the Son of God has come, and he has given us understanding so that we can know the true God. And now we are in God because we are in his Son, Jesus Christ. He is the only true God, and he is eternal life.

# **❖** Hope from our TRIALS and TROUBLES that can so easily control us:

And He will be called ... Prince of Peace ...

## 1. Christmas is our BRIDGE to PEACE.

God was in Christ, making peace between the world and himself. In Christ, God did not hold the world guilty of its sins. And He gave us the message of peace.

2 Corinthians 5:19 (NCV)

### 3. Peace doesn't come CHEAP.

But he was wounded and crushed for our sins. He was beaten that we might have peace. He was whipped, and we were healed!
