Christmas is the Season of Joy:

**❖** Recognizing When I Have Lost My Joy:

"Restore unto me the JOY of my salvation..."

Psalm 51:12 (NIV)

1. Step 1 - I have to REALIZE I have LOST IT.

"Why are you downcast, O my soul? Why so disturbed within me?"

Psalm 42:5a (NIV)

2. Step 2 - I need to ANALYZE the CAUSE of losing my JOY.

Let us examine our ways and test them, and let us return to the Lord.

Lamentations 3:40 (NIV)

3. Step 3 - I must take the <u>TIME</u> to work on <u>CORRECTING</u> the <u>PROBLEM</u>.

"When you obey me, you remain in my love, just as I obey my Father and remain in his love. <sup>11</sup>I have told you this so that you will be filled with my JOY. Yes, your JOY will overflow!"

John 15:10-11 (NLT)

4. Step 4 - I will decide to <u>FOCUS</u> on the <u>GOOD</u> and <u>RELEASE</u> the <u>NEGATIVE</u>.

"The Lord has done great things for us, and we are filled with JOY."

Psalm 126:3 (NIV)

5. Step 5 - I have to <u>SPEND TIME</u> with and <u>WORSHIP GOD</u> daily.

"Your words are what sustain me. They bring me great JOY and are my heart's delight, for I bear your name, O Lord God Almighty."

Jeremiah 15:16 (NLT)

6. Step 6 - I begin to get my <u>JOY BACK</u> as I practice <u>GIVING BACK</u>.

It is God himself who has given us new lives from Christ Jesus; and long ages ago he planned that we should spend these lives in helping others.

Ephesians 2:10 (LB)

7. Step 7 - I experience the greatest sense of joy as I TELL OTHERS about JESUS.

"I tell you there is more JOY in heaven over one sinner who changes his heart and life, than over ninety-nine good people who don't need to change."

Luke 15:7 (NCV)

Closing Truth: The greatest joy on <u>EARTH</u> is taking someone with you to <u>HEAVEN</u>. In your hearts set apart Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect.
