One of the teachers of the law came and heard them debating. Choosing to Put <u>GOD FIRST</u>:

"Of all the commandments, which is the most important?" ²⁹"The most important one," answered Jesus, "is this: 'Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is (number) one.'" Mark 12:28-30 (NIV)

1. There can only be <u>ONE GOD</u>.

2. This God is LORD (Yahweh).

"God, the Lord, created the heavens and stretched them out. He created the earth and everything in it. He gives breath and life to everyone in all the world."

3. This God is <u>PERSONAL</u> (Jesus).

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ²He was with God in the beginning... ¹⁴The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

Choosing to <u>LOVE</u> God <u>MOST</u>:

"Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength."

 Loving God with all your <u>HEART</u>... our <u>EMOTIONS</u>. And then Jesus added, "It is the thought-life that defiles you. ²¹For from within, out of a person's heart, come evil thoughts, sexual immorality, theft, murder..."

 Loving God with all your <u>SOUL</u>... our <u>CONSCIOUSNESS</u>. Dear friends, I urge you, as aliens and strangers in the world, to abstain from sinful desires, which war against your soul.

4. Loving God with all your <u>STRENGTH</u>... our <u>ACTIVITIES</u>. Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. ¹¹Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. ¹²For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.
