WE ARE CALLED TO GATHER

With many other words Peter warned them; and he pleaded with them, "Save yourselves from this corrupt generation." ⁴¹Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day. ⁴²They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. ⁴³Everyone was filled with awe, and many wonders and miraculous signs were done by the apostles. ⁴⁴All the believers were together and had everything in common. ⁴⁵Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need. ⁴⁶Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, ⁴⁷praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

Called to Gather for WORSHIP:

And now, Israel, what does the Lord your God require of you? He requires you to fear him, to live according to his will, to love and worship him with all your heart and soul, ¹³ and to observe the Lord's commands and decrees that I am giving you today for your own good?

Deuteronomy 10:12-13 (NLT)

1. God takes our <u>WORSHIP</u> seriously.

"Do not worship any other gods besides me. ⁸Do not make idols of any kind, whether in the shape of birds or animals or fish. ⁹You must never worship or bow down to them, for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God who will not share your affection with any other god!"

2. Worship is showing my <u>LOVE</u> to God because of His <u>LOVE</u> for me. We love Him because he first loved us.

1 John 4:19 (NIV)

• We've become <u>SELF-CENTERED</u>... We worship <u>SELF</u>.

Focusing on the self is the opposite of focusing on God. Anyone completely absorbed in self ignores God, ends up thinking more about self than God. That person ignores who God is and what he is doing.

• We live in a <u>SELF-CENTERED</u> <u>CULTURE</u>... We worship <u>US</u>.

Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, fix your attention on God... Unlike the culture around you, always dragging you down to its level of immaturity.

3. Worship is not just about <u>US</u>... It's about <u>US TOGETHER</u>.

Do not avoiding worshiping together as some do but spurring each other on, especially as we see the big Day approaching.
