❖ You Were Created to GROW UP:

This work must continue until we are all joined together in the same faith and in the same knowledge of the Son of God. We must become like a mature person, growing until we become like Christ and have his perfection.

1. God's <u>PURPOSE</u> for us is to become more like <u>JESUS</u>, His perfect Son.

For God knew his people in advance, and he chose them to become like his Son, so that his Son would be the firstborn, with many brothers and sisters.

2. God's <u>PLAN</u> for us is to <u>GROW UP</u> to maturity that others can see Christ in us.

❖ Things that <u>HINDER</u> our <u>SPIRITUAL</u> <u>GROWTH</u>:

1. Our PERSONAL PRIDE.

Brothers, I could not address you as spiritual but as worldly—mere infants in Christ. ²I gave you milk, not solid food, for you were not yet ready for it. ❖ Biblical Steps Necessary for <u>GROWING UP</u>:

We ought always to thank God for you, brothers, and rightly so, because your faith is growing more and more, and the love every one of you has for each other is increasing.

1. It begins with a proper ATTITUDE.

Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. ⁴Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others. ⁵Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus. Philippians 2:3-5 (NIV)

2. It is supported with right ACTIONS.

Dear children, let us stop just saying we love each other; let us really show it by our actions. ¹⁹It is by our actions that we know we are living in the truth, so we will be confident when we stand before the Lord.

• Spend time in GOD'S WORD
