We are Christ's ambassadors...

2 Corinthians 5:20a (NLT)

We are called to <u>SERVE</u> (Like Jesus). "Your attitude must be like My Own, for I did not come to be served, but to serve..." Matthew 20:28 (LB)

- A is for <u>ATTITUDE</u>... I is for <u>INITIATIVE</u>... M is for <u>MULTIPLICATION</u>.
- Serving like Jesus means being <u>AVAILABLE</u> when called upon to serve. Two blind men... shouted, "Lord, have mercy on us!" ... Jesus stopped and called to them. "What do you want Me to do for you?"

Matthew 20:30, 32 (NIV)

 Serving like Jesus means being <u>GRATEFUL</u> for the opportunity to serve. Jesus looked up and said, "Father, I thank you that you have heard Me. <sup>42</sup>I knew that you always hear Me, but I said this for the benefit of the people standing here."

John 11:41-42 (NIV)

- Serving like Jesus means being <u>FAITHFUL</u> in fulfilling your service.
   *"I have brought You glory on earth by completing the work You gave me to do."* John 17:4 (NIV)
- ✤ We are called to <u>SHARE</u>:

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Acts 1:8 (NIV)

1. The people in our <u>JERUSALEM/JUDEA</u>... Those in our sphere of <u>INFLUENCE</u>. "Go back home and tell people how much God has done for you." So the man went all over town telling how much Jesus had done for him."

Luke 8:39 (NCV)

 With people in our <u>SAMARIA</u>... Those close to us but <u>DIFFERENT</u> from us. But dedicate your lives to Christ as Lord. Always be ready to defend your confidence in God when anyone asks you to explain it. However, make your defense with gentleness and respect.

1 Peter 3:15 (GW)

3. To the <u>ENDS</u> of the <u>EARTH</u>... People <u>AROUND</u> the <u>WORLD</u> who haven't heard. The Lord isn't really being slow about his promise to return, as some people think. No, He is being patient for your sake. He does not want anyone to perish, so He is giving more time for everyone to repent.

2 Peter 3:9 (NLT)

God's Promises to Us... If We are Faithful in <u>SERVING</u> and <u>SHARING</u>: The one thing required of servants is that they be faithful.

1 Corinthians 4:2 (TEV)

1. 1<sup>st</sup> Promise if you are faithful: Your Service will <u>REMAIN</u>. Throw yourselves into the work of the Master, confident that nothing you do for Him is a waste of time or effort.

1 Corinthians 15:58 (MSG)

 2<sup>nd</sup> Promise if you are faithful: You'll receive <u>HEAVENLY</u> <u>RECOGNITION</u>. He will not forget how hard you have worked for Him and how you have shown your love to Him by caring for other Christians.

Hebrews 6:10 (NLT)

3<sup>rd</sup> Promise if you are faithful: You will be given an <u>ETERNAL REWARD</u>.
 "Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things so; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master's happiness!"
 Matthews 25:21 (NIV)
