MADE TO MAKE A HAND OFF

One generation shall commend your works to another, and shall declare your mighty acts. Psalm 145:4 (ESV)

Four Questions to Ask About the Handoff:

- 1. Why is the hand off important?
 - Because the time is <u>SHORT</u>, and eternity is <u>FOREVER</u>.
 - Because the time is <u>CRITICAL</u>.
- 2. Who handed it off to me?

- 3. What am I handing off?

• The baton of <u>FAITH</u>.

The baton of <u>SCRIPTURE</u>.
Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth.

2 Timothy 2:15 (ESV)

But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it ¹⁵ and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. ¹⁶ All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, ¹⁷ that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

4. What happens when we MISS the HANDOFF?

For people will be lovers of self, lovers of money, proud, arrogant, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, ³heartless, unappeasable, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not loving good, ⁴treacherous, reckless, swollen with conceit, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, ⁵having the appearance of godliness, but denying its power.
