(God's Power) that raised Christ from the dead and seated him in the place of honor at God's right hand in the heavenly realms. ²¹Now he is far above any ruler or authority or power or leader or anything else in this world or in the world to come.

2. God's mission plan is that we are to MULTIPLY OURSELVES.

"...go and make disciples in all the nations..."

3. God's mission plan is that we lead others into MEMBERSHIP in God's family.

"... baptizing them into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit..."

4. God's mission plan is that we are to help believers MATURE in their faith.

"... teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you..."

5. God's mission plan doesn't end until JESUS RETURNS.

"... and be sure of this--that I am with you always, even to the end of the world."

❖ The Mission PEOPLE God Has Called to Carry Out His Plan:

So when they met together, they asked him, "Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?" ⁷He said to them: "It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority. ⁸But (Your Name Here) will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." ⁹After he said this, he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight.

1. God fills His people with the <u>POWER</u> and <u>ABILITY</u> to carry out His plan. "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you..."

It was he who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, ¹²to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up... ¹³and become mature.
