BE THE PARENT

Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. ² "Honor your father and mother"—which is the first commandment with a promise—³ "so that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth." ⁴ Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord.

Parents Lead BIBLICALLY.

"Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the Lord your God is giving you."

1. Teach them to LOVE the LORD.

2. Teach them to LIVE in PURITY.

God wants you to live a pure life. Keep yourselves from sexual promiscuity.

3. Teach them to be <u>FINANCIALLY</u> <u>FREE</u>.

For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.

Parents Lead CONSISTENTLY.

Above all, my brothers, do not swear—not by heaven or by earth or by anything else. Let your "Yes" be yes, and your "No," no, or you will be condemned.

1. Your children need to see you <u>DISCIPLINE</u> with <u>LOVE</u>.

A refusal to correct is a refusal to love; love your children by disciplining them.

2. Your children need to have CLEAR BOUNDARIES.

Discipline your children while there is hope. If you don't, you will ruin their lives.

3. You must respond QUICKLY and APPROPRIATELY when they challenge authority.

Don't be afraid to correct your young ones; a spanking won't kill them.

❖ Parents Lead Toward ETERNITY.

Train a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not turn from it.

1. Guide them toward a <u>PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP</u> with God.

But watch out! Be very careful never to forget what you have seen the Lord do for you. Do not let these things escape from your mind as long as you live! And be sure to pass them on to your children and grandchildren.

2. Lead them away from the <u>DANGEROUS FOLLY</u> of this <u>WORLD</u>.

In the future, when you have children and grandchildren and have lived in the land a long time, do not corrupt yourselves by making idols of any kind. This is evil in the sight of the Lord your God and will arouse His anger.

3. Let them see the PRIORITY of CHRIST in your life.

Even while these people were worshiping the Lord, they were serving their idols. To this day their children and grandchildren continue to do as their fathers did.
