1. I am dependent on God to strengthen me and hold me up.

"So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."

Isaiah 41:10 (NIV)

2. I am dependent on God to protect me and hold me close.

"I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of my hand."

3. When God's hand is involved, I see miracles happen.
