- 1. Faith is not WISHFUL THINKING.
- 2. Faith is not an EMPTY HOPE.
- 3. Faith is a <u>CONFIDENT ASSURANCE</u> based on a <u>FOUNDATIONAL TRUTH</u>.
- Hindrances to Our Faith:
 - 1. Hindrance is DOUBT.
