- Why Work Doesn't Work for Us...
 - 1. When we work just to get more <u>STUFF</u>.

And he told them this parable: "The ground of a certain rich man produced a good crop. ¹⁷ He thought to himself, 'What shall I do? I have no place to store my crops.' ¹⁸ "Then he said, 'This is what I'll do. I will tear down my barns and build bigger ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods. ¹⁹ And I'll say to myself, "You have plenty of good things laid up for many years. Take life easy; eat, drink and be merry.'" ²⁰ "But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your life will be demanded from you. Then who will get what you have prepared for yourself?' ²¹ "This is how it will be with anyone who stores up things for himself but is not rich toward God."

1. When we work out of <u>PRIDE</u> or to grow our <u>EGO</u>.

This is what the LORD says: "Let not the wise man boast of his wisdom or the strong man boast of his strength or the rich man boast of his riches, ²⁴ but let him who boasts boast about this: that he understands and knows me, that I am the LORD, who exercises kindness, justice and righteousness on earth, for in these I delight," declares the LORD. 2. When we work to earn the <u>LOVE</u> and <u>APPROVAL</u> of others.

Don't be selfish; don't live to make a good impression on others. Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourself.

Philippians 2:3 (NLT)

- How Can We Lead Our Family to Understand the Value of Work?
 - 1. <u>HONOR GOD</u> in and through your work.

Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men. Colossians 3:23 (NIV)

2. <u>FOLLOW</u> your <u>LEADERS</u>.

Obey your leaders and submit to their authority. They keep watch over you as men who must give an account. Obey them so that their work will be a joy, not a burden, for that would be of no advantage to you.

3. Choose to <u>BE HAPPY</u>.

God gives man wealth and possessions, and enables him to enjoy them; to accept his lot and be happy in his work-this is a gift of God.

4. Be a <u>TEAM PLAYER</u>.

Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others. ⁵ Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: ⁶ Who, being in very nature God... ⁷ made Himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant...

5. <u>WORK HARD</u> and give it your best effort.
