Understanding Idols (Idols in the Bible)

Those who make idols become like them, and so will those who put their trust in them.

Psalm 115:18 (GW)

- 1. Baal the god of possessions... the idol of money.
- 2. Ashteroth the god of sensuality... the idol of sex.
- 3. Molech the god of wisdom... the idol of knowledge.
- Key Truth: Manmade gods have remained the same throughout history.
- The Danger of Following Idols

What's the use of an idol? It's only something a man has made. What good does it do... to trust it?

Habakkuk 2:18 (NIV)

1. Idols will <u>DISAPPOINT</u> me.

Those who make idols are disillusioned because the gods they make are false and lifeless.

Jeremiah 10:14 (TEV)

2. Idols will **DOMINATE** me.

You know that when you were pagans, somehow or other you were influenced and led astray to mute idols.

1 Corinthians 12:2 (NIV)

3. Idols will DEFORM me.

They worshipped worthless idols and became worthless themselves.

Jeremiah 2:5 (GN)

Key Truth: Idols offer great promise, but they never produce.

"For your own good...don't sin by making an idol in any form at all."

Why Do People Create Idols?

Many exchange the truth about God for a lie; they worship and serve what God has created instead of the Creator himself.

Romans 1:25 (TEV)

- 1. We attempt to limit GOD'S PRESENCE... create a God we can PUT on a SHELF.
- 2. We attempt to limit GOD'S POWER... create a God that JUSTIFIES our CHOICES.
- 3. We attempt to limit GOD'S POSITION... create a God that AGREES with US.
- The Benefits of Removing Idols and Worshipping God

O Israel, if you will truly return to me and absolutely discard your idols, ² and if you will swear by me alone, the living God, and begin to live good, honest, clean lives, then you will be a testimony to the nations of the world, and they will come to me and glorify my name.

1. I will find DELIGHT... it will give me FULFILLMENT in my life.

Seek your happiness in the Lord and He will give you your hearts desire.

Psalm 37:4 (TEV)

Whoever believes in Him will not be disappointed.

2. I will have <u>DELIVERANCE</u>... it will give me <u>FREEDOM</u> in my life.

Jesus said, "If you obey my teaching... ³²you will know the truth and the truth will set you free."

John 8:31-32 (TEV)

"If the Son sets you free, you will be really free."

John 8:36 (NIV)

3. I will be <u>DEVELOPED</u>... it will give me a <u>FOUNDATION</u> for my life.
