I CAN TRUST THE BIBLE BECAUSE...

- The Bible is <u>HISTORICALLY</u> accurate although the Bible is not a <u>HISTORY</u> book.
 - 1. It stands the <u>EYEWITNESS</u> test.
 - 2. The EXTREME CARE by which the Bible was COPIED over the years.
 - 3. Historical <u>ARCHEOLOGY</u> proves that the Bible is <u>ACCURATE</u>.
- The Bible is <u>SCIENTIFICALLY</u> accurate although the Bible is not a <u>SCIENCE</u> book.
 - 1. God created all <u>TRUTH</u> science is nothing more than <u>DISCOVERING</u> it.
 - 2. Not only does the Bible not give <u>BAD SCIENCE</u> it is usually ahead of <u>SCIENCE</u>.
 - 3. Not one place in the Bible can you discover an <u>INNACURATE SCIENTIFIC</u> fact.
- The Bible is <u>PROPHETICALLY</u> accurate
 - 1. There are 300+ <u>PROPHECIES</u> about Jesus that all <u>CAME TRUE</u>.
 - 2. Nobody volunteered to be a <u>PROPHET</u>... if you were <u>WRONG</u> you were <u>STONED</u>.
 - 3. The numerical odds of all these <u>PROPHECIES</u> coming true are <u>ASTRONOMICAL</u>.

HOW TO INTEGRATE GOD'S WORD INTO MY LIFE

- First, I must <u>DECIDE</u> to make the Bible the <u>FOUNDATION</u> for my <u>LIFE</u>.
 - 1. I can choose to build my life on the foundation of <u>POPULAR CULTURE</u>.
 - 2. I can choose to build my life on PERSONAL REASON.
 - 3. I can choose to build my life on my PRIVATE EMOTIONS.
- ◆ I must choose the <u>DISCIPLINE</u> of making God's Word my <u>STANDARD</u> for living.

• Key Truth: You can't <u>REMEMBER</u> and <u>UTILIZE</u> what you don't <u>KNOW</u>.

"Jesus answered, 'It is written, Man does not live on bread alone."

◆ I must <u>DEVOTE</u> myself to being <u>OPEN</u> to the truth in God's Word.

PARABLE OF THE SOWER, FOUR KINDS OF SOILS, RECEPTIVITY (Luke 8)

1. First there is the <u>HARDENED</u> <u>SOIL</u>.

"A farmer went out to sow his seed. As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path; it was trampled on, and the birds of the air ate it up..."

2. Then there is the <u>SHALLOW</u> <u>SOIL</u>.

"Some fell on rock, and when it came up, the plants withered because they had no moisture..."

3. There is the <u>SOIL</u> covered with <u>WEEDS</u>.

"Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up with it and choked the plants..."

4. Finally there is the <u>GOOD</u> <u>SOIL</u>, <u>FERTILIZED</u> and <u>FRUITFUL</u>.

"Still other seed fell on good soil. It came up and yielded a crop, a hundred times more than was sown."

- I must commit to <u>DO</u> what God's Word <u>SAYS</u> to do.
 - Key Truth: God's Word doesn't offer us <u>SUGGESTIONS</u> but <u>COMMANDMENTS</u>.

"Remember, it is sin to know what you ought to do and then not do it." James 4:17 (NLT)

◆ I must <u>DISCOVER</u> the freedom that comes from <u>TRUSTING</u> in God's Word.

"Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path." Psalm 119:105 (NIV)

• Key Truth: When you live in a <u>DARK WORLD</u> you need a <u>LIGHT</u> to <u>GUIDE</u> you.

"The people living in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death a light has dawned." Matthew 4:16 (NIV)
