A CALL TO FOLLOW

"Jesus and his disciples went on to the villages around Caesarea Philippi. On the way he asked them, 'Who do people say I am?' Or what can a man give in exchange for his soul? If anyone is ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when he comes in his Father's glory with the holy angels.'"

Mark 8:27 (NIV)

- 1. Some say <u>JOHN</u> the <u>BAPTIST</u>.
 - "Today many people make a decision about Jesus based on what others say."
- 2. Some say ELIJAH or one of the other PROPHETS.
 - Some people have determined that Jesus was a great teacher but stop at that."
- 3. You are the <u>CHRIST</u>.
 - "Many people are looking for a Jesus that fits what they want, not who He is."
- Why Did He Come?

- 1. Jesus for the first time clearly EXPLAINS His MISSION.
- 2. Peter <u>RESPONDS</u>, along with all of the disciples, that is not <u>WHAT</u> they <u>WANT</u>.

"When we argue with God's Word we will open the door for Satan's lies."

3. Jesus then calls Peter a tool of <u>SATAN</u>, because that is what Satan would want also.

What He Expects from Us

2. A true disciple must <u>IDENTIFY</u> with Him through <u>SUFFERING</u> and <u>DEATH</u>.

3. A true disciple must <u>FOLLOW</u> Him wherever He <u>LEADS</u>.
