WHY EASTER REALLY MATTERS

"When the Sabbath was over, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices so that they might go to anoint Jesus' body. Very early on the first day of the week, just after sunrise, they were on their way to the tomb and they asked each other, 'Who will roll the stone away from the entrance of the tomb?' - ❖ "Easter Matters" because it **CONFIRMS** who **JESUS** is.
 - 1. Jesus is the PERSON He claimed to be.

 - 1. I'm Going to Heaven because I am SINCERE.

3. I'm Going to Heaven by SUBTRACTION.
