Understanding the Context of 1 John

- 2. John was in **EPHESUS** his later years and wrote this letter to them and others.
- 3. John wrote this letter to combat <u>FALSE TEACHINGS</u> about Jesus.
- **Key Truth:** Jesus is FULLY GOD and FULLY MAN.

Jesus is the final WORD for our Life

1. This WORD is ETERNAL.

2. This WORD is PERSONAL.

"...which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked at and our hands have touched..."

3. This WORD is DIVINE.

"And our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ."

❖ As Christians we are Known by "How We Walk"

"This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is light; in him there is no darkness at all. - 1. God through Jesus Christ is the **SOURCE** of all **LIGHT**.
- 2. We are not WALKING with Jesus if we are WALKING in DARKNESS.
- 3. If we realize we have <u>WANDERED</u> from the light Jesus is ready to <u>FORGIVE</u>.
