#### THE MATURING OF MARRIAGE

In the same way, husbands ought to love their wives as they love their own bodies. For a man who loves his wife actually shows love for himself.<sup>29</sup> No one hates his own body but feeds and cares for it, just as Christ cares for the church.<sup>30</sup> And we are members of his body.<sup>31</sup> As the Scriptures say, "A man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, and the two are united into one. This is a great mystery, but it is an illustration of the way Christ and the church are one.<sup>33</sup> So again I say, each man must love his wife as he loves himself, and the wife must respect her husband. Ephesians 5:28-33

# • There is a difference between a <u>CONSUMER</u> relationship and a <u>COVENANT</u> relationship.

Some Pharisees came and tried to trap him with this question: "Should a man be allowed to divorce his wife for just any reason?" "Haven't you read the Scriptures?" Jesus replied. "They record that from the beginning 'God made them male and female.""<sup>5</sup> And he said, "'This explains why a man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, and the two are united into one.'<sup>6</sup> Since they are no longer two but one, let no one split apart what God has joined together."

- Contract is based on <u>MUTUAL</u> <u>DISTRUST</u>
